Intricacy is the highly anticipated debut album by Friday Bridge. It's about anonymity, volatility and literature. About Mannerism and cheap drinks, Jeanne de Vauds and Martin Fry. *Intricacy* can be described as cynic tales disguised into electronic beauty. The thirteen tracks on the album exist in a unique musical universe, but one where you can see shadows of Mylène Farmer, Dannii Minogue, Louis Philippe and Human League.

Intricacy is produced by Niklas Gustafsson—from *The Higher Elevations* and *This Year's Model*—together with Friday Bridge. On *Pigeon*, Friday Bridge joins forces with Fosca frontman and London profile Dickon Edwards.

Before *Intricacy*, Friday Bridge has released an EP on Swedish indie label Bedroom, contributed to the Friendly Noise compilation *Are You Scared to Get Happy?* as well as releasing a split 7" with Kelly Slusher in the US and a split CD single with Le Sport. Single track *It Girl* has received extensive air play in various countries.
